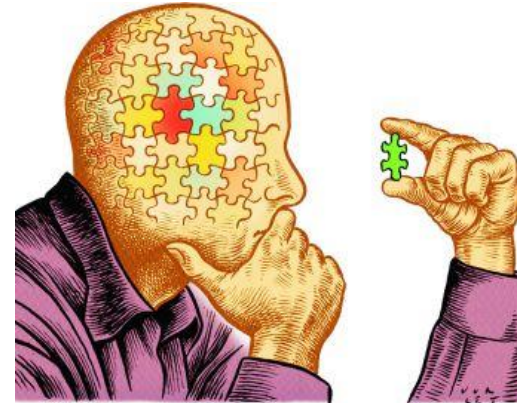


Critical Thinking Resources
