

# Where Have We Come From? Ancient Civilisations

Throughout Term Two you will be developing your skills as a historian by researching a particular Ancient Civilisation. You will be required to select one of the following civilisations:

*Rome, Greece, Egypt, Mesopotamia, China, Ancient Olmec*

## Culminating Task – Assessment Requirements

To demonstrate your knowledge, you will be required to design a presentation which explores the daily life of a person in your chosen civilisation.

- a) Identify a person or member of an ancient society. You will need to decide the gender, age and social status of the person you are portraying.
- b) Investigate and explain the daily life, role and work of various groups, their beliefs, leisure activities, key events, ways culture was expressed, trade and contact with other cultures

Based on your research you will become an individual from your chosen ancient civilisation. *It is more than just presenting a speech- try and think outside the square!*

### Support Material:

You will be provided with two authentic question sheet (**called 5Ws and How**) and two checklists- a **research checklist** and a **presentation planning checklist**. These will need to be completed and submitted at the end of the unit.

### Audience:

You will present your work to the Year 7 families and students and the staff of Marcellin College

### Presentation Date:

All presentations will occur during 'A Night at the Museum' on **Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June 7.00pm – 8.30pm** in the Admara classrooms. Each space in Ardmara will be allocated to a certain civilisation.
