We partner teachers to develop National Curriculum Documentation into practical, dynamic curriculum that teachers can readily implement in their school context.

## Workshop Outline

In this 3 hour workshop you will build on your understanding of the importance of quality, varied feedback in the design process.

- We will look at Peter Skillman's *Marshmallow Challenge* as an activity that provides great insight into the iterative process and how feedback plays a critical role in improving the final product.
- This links with John Hattie's Visible Learning concept powerfully, as his research identifies *feedback* as the single most powerful influence over student learning.
- The National Curriculum emphasises the need for students to develop capability in monitoring their own learning, and for teachers to provide different types of feedback, whilst nationally regulated tests (such as NAPLAN) focus on summative assessment of progression.
